Minutes

J McFarland motioned/L Thies seconded minutes of the July 18, 2023 meeting were approved as written. *Motion carried*.

Financial Report & Expenditure Report

A financial report was given by J Buhnekempe showing a July 31, 2023 balance of \$1,588,625.54 along with an Expenditure Statement for bills to be approved for \$23,672.37. D Mahon motioned/B Yochum seconded to accept the financial and approve expenditure reports. (Roll call vote: Approving votes: J McFarland, P Kuhns, D Campbell, J Maguire, L Thies, D Budde, D Mahon, B Yochum, J Buhnerkempe; Disapproving votes: 0; Absent: 0). *Motion carried*.

Deb Ruholl- County Treasurer —Reported on Investing Funds. We are currently only receiving .85% for our Dieterich Bank account. She is suggesting investing some money into a 6-month CD, currently receiving 5.3 — 4.25% or a Money Market currently receiving 4.71%, which includes 6 withdrawals a month. Suggestions were made to have an Operating Fund or cash account to cover operating expenses and invest \$500,000 in CD's and \$500,000 into a money market. Deb Ruholl will check with legal counsel, regarding the Illinois State Statue, on how 911 can invest their money. This will be on the agenda for September.

System Administrator's Report - Tina Daniels

- T Daniels attended the monthly Statewide 911 Administrator's call on July 6th. They were given an update on the Safe2Help program. Bullying and harassment is still the highest reported issue at 40.2%.
- T Daniels and B Bales attended the INENA Region 6 and 7 meeting on July 19th in Mt. Vernon, IL.
 There was discussion on NG911 and redundancy, TC training and credentialing and issues with the 5G
 network and how it's causing mapping accuracy issues.
- On July 25th, Daniels and Bales attended a meeting put on by RapidSOS. They were shown some of the features of RapidSOS Premium and were impressed with the accuracy of their 911 wireless call phase 2

location plotting and the added features that is offered with Premium. They had a conference call this morning with RapidSOS and will be obtaining a quote for the RapidSOS Premium for Effingham 911.

• T Daniels attended this month's Statewide Administrator call on August 3rd. They were told that the state is working on trainings, including; 590 (the Crisis Care system), 988 (the Suicide and Crisis lifeline) and 911 Telecommunicator certification.

P Kuhns motioned/D Mahon seconded to accept the System Administrator's Report

Old Business

- Global/BeckTech Report on Lightning Damage Chris Overbeck reported the total bill for Global came to a little over \$9,000. The microwave dishes were not damaged and could be reused. We have not received a bill from BeckTech to date. Overbeck suggested not to close this claim because some unforeseen issues may present in the next months.
- Overbeck said there are still issues with the Fire Department's phone lines. The IFERN issues do not seem to be related to the lightning strike. He has suggested to do away with the phone lines and put up our own point to point microwave link. He is guessing the cost to be about \$20,000. This would eliminate a monthly Consolidated bill. Overbeck will get a quote and bring back to September's meeting. Maguire suggested getting a quote from Consolidated for replacing the dry copper with fiber vs. the cost of the microwave link.
- Tower Lease Agreement Questions Chris Overbeck reported they have received Beecher City, Teutopolis & Edgewood's Tower Lease agreements back. E.J. Water and the Village of Dieterich are pending, due to a change on page 5, 9b. They do not want to have to get 911's permission to access their own site. Our State's Attorney is reviewing that change.
- Update on County-Wide Simulcast System for County Fire Departments Chris Overbeck reported the City's system is getting ready; the staging process is currently in place. The County estimated date to be ready is mid-2024. There are still too many unanswered questions. They cannot order any frequencies until the Tower Site Agreements are final.
- Update on New Generator Chad Walls checked with Niebrugge's and the ship date is set for December 6, 2023.

None reported.


