- Daniels reported our contract with Solacom, our phone vendor, is expiring next year. Solacom has been bought out and we have not had good service recently. Chris Overbeck will make sure the Landowners Agreements are completed. All ARPA distributions will be reported monthly to the County Board. Dave Campbell will take the report to the 911 Board. All ARPA funds need allocated by 2024 and spent by 2026. The City's equipment invoices for their tower upgrades will go directly to 911 for payment. D Budde motioned/B Yochum seconded to assign Teutopolis Fire District as the NASPO Host for Procurement of a County-Wide Simulcast System. 
### General Information/Public Comments
